Remote Control

Connect the BPL Smart Remote to your TV to operate the TV.

When you turn on the TV for the first time, the BPL Smart Remote pairs to the TV automatically. If the BPL Smart Remote does not pair to the TV automatically, point it at the front of the TV, then press and hold the and buttons simultaneously for 3 seconds or more.

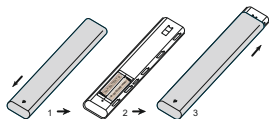


Button	
(Power)	Press to turn the TV on or off. For The Frame model, When watching TV, press to switch to Art mode. In Art mode, press to switch to the Home screen. Press and hold to turn off the TV completely.
MIC / LED	Used as MIC when using voice recognition with the remote control. Do not impact the MIC hole or use a sharp object to poke into the hole.
(Voice Assistant)	Runs Voice Assistant. Press and hold the button, say a command, and then release the button to run Voice Assistant.
(Settings / Number / Colour button)	You can access Settings menu / virtual numeric pad / Colour buttons / Option pad / SmartThings app directly. - Accessing the SmartThings app using this button may not be supported, depending on the model. - Use this button to access additional options that are specific to the feature in use. - Press to bring up the virtual numeric pad on the screen. Use the numeric keypad to enter numeric values. Select numbers and then select Done or Enter Number to enter a numeric value. Use to change the channel, enter a PIN, ZIP code and etc.
Directional button (up, down, left, right)	Moves the focus and changes the values seen on the TV's menu.
Select	Select or runs a focused item. When pressed while you are watching a broadcast programme, detailed programme information appears.
(Return)	Press to return to the previous menu. When pressed for 1 second or more, the running function is terminated. When pressed while you are watching a programme, the previous channel appears.
(Smart Hub)	Press to switch to the Home Screen.
(Play/pause)	When pressed, the playback controls appear. Using these controls, you can control the media content that is playing
+ / - (Volume)	Move the button up or down to adjust the volume. To mute the sound, press the button. When pressed for 2 seconds or more, the Accessibility Shortcuts appears. - may not be present, depending on the model. - To access mute, press the joystick vertically.
(Channel)	Move the button up or down to change the channel. To see the Guide or Channel List screen, press the button. (The Guide or Channel List screen appears depending on the geographical area.) When pressed for 1 second or more, the Channel List screen appears.

Remote Control

Fitting the batteries into the remote control

1. Turn the remote control over and push the battery compartment cover in the direction of the arrow. Remove the battery compartment cover.



2. Insert the supplied batteries into the remote control. Make sure that you insert the batteries correctly with the polarity as shown inside the battery compartment.
3. Replace the battery compartment cover and push in the opposite direction to the arrow until it clicks into place.

Notes on Using Batteries:

The use of the wrong type of batteries may cause chemical leakage and/or explosion. Please note the following:

- Always ensure that the batteries are inserted with the + and - terminals in the correct direction as shown in the battery compartment.
- Different types of batteries have different characteristics. Do not mix different types.
- Do not mix old and new batteries. Mixing old and new batteries will shorten battery life and/or cause chemical leakage.
- Replace batteries as soon as the remote stops working.
- Chemical that leak from batteries may cause skin irritation. If any chemical matter seeps out of the batteries, wipe it up immediately with a dry cloth.
- The batteries may have a shorter life expectancy due to storage conditions. Remove the batteries whenever you anticipate that the remote control will not be used for an extended period.
- The batteries (battery pack or batteries installed) shall not be exposed to excessive heat such as sunshine, fire or the like.

CAUTION:

- It may result in an explosion if batteries are replaced incorrectly.
- Only replace batteries with the same or equivalent type.
- Ensure ISI standard marked battery used in remote control.

- ♦ Check expiry date of battery mentioned on battery.

- ♦ It's recommended to use Alkaline battery for long lasting. Also, Alkaline batteries are less likely to leak.

After Use

Cleaning



Warning: Make sure the device is unplugged from the mains power. Before cleaning. Otherwise, there is a risk of electrocution!

Never spill or spray any type of liquid into the unit. Only use a clean, dry cloth for cleaning the casing. Never use aggressive liquids. When very dirty, use a slightly dampened cloth. Clean the screen with a special cleaning cloth for screens.



Caution: When you clean the screen, hold the device steady with one hand and carefully clean the screen with the other. Otherwise, the device could tip over and get damaged or cause injuries.

Storage when not in use

If you do not plan to use the device for an extended period of time, unplug the power cord from the socket and remove the batteries from the remote control. Make sure that the storage temperature is between 15°C and 45°C and the relative humidity does not exceed 90%.

Transport

If you wish to move the device a short distance, proceed as follows to transport the device:

1. Disconnect the device from the mains.
2. Remove all cables connected to the device.
3. If you wish to move the device outside your building, demount the base and the optional side supports or the mounted wall-bracket by reversing the procedure.
4. Pack the TV set up carefully. Take special care to ensure the corners of the casing and the screen are well protected.
5. Take the TV set and its accessories to its new location and recommission it.

Troubleshooting

Cannot control the TV with the remote control.	● Check the remote control sensor on the product and try again. ● Check if there is any obstacle between the product and the remote control. ● Check if the batteries are still working and properly installed (⊕ to ⊕, ⊖ to ⊖).
No image display and no sound is produced.	● Check if the product is turned on. ● Check if the power cord is connected to a wall outlet. ● Check if there is a problem in the wall outlet by connecting other products.
The TV turns off suddenly.	● Check the power control settings. The power supply may be interrupted. ● Check if the auto-off function is activated on the settings related time. The auto-off function may have worked. This product is equipped with an auto-off function that automatically turns off the power if the remote control is not used for 15 minutes without an input signal.
When connecting to the PC (HDMI), no signal is detected.	● Turn the TV off/on using the remote control. ● Reconnect the HDMI cable. ● Restart the PC with the TV on.
